QUALITATIVE METHODOLOGY

He has developed specialized skills in qualitative research methods (in particular: ethnography, team-ethnography, autoethnography and visual methods).

SOCIOLOGY OF VIOLENCE AND TOTAL INSTITUTIONS

Throughout his long-lasting research experience in prisons – since his Master degree program – he developed a broad interest in the Sociology of violence and power, deepened along his fellowship at the Centre for Criminology at Oxford University.

SOCIOLOGY OF HEALTH

He developed his first interests in the field of mental health since 2014, when he was conducting ethnography at the Forensic Psychiatric Hospital in Reggio Emilia (Italy). He conceived, designed and coordinated with Professor Cardano the research titled “Psychiatric interventions” on involuntary hospitalization and mechanical restraint in psychiatry, for which he conducted a quick ethnography in 25 psychiatric wards in Piedmont, visiting each Emergency Department as well. He then conducted two ethnographic case studies (using participant observation and in-depth interviews) within two psychiatric hospital wards, spending two months in each context.
