Over the past ten years I have conducted a number of research, teaching and publication activities dealing with migration studies, urban inclusion and exclusion dynamic, community based activation and its relation with urban policies and planning mechanisms, urban regeneration and social innovation. On these topics, I had the opportunity to do fieldwork in **different countries** of Europe (Italy, Germany, Spain, The Netherlands), North America (Canada), Africa (South Africa, Kenya) and Latin America (Mexico). I combine theoretical and comparative elaborations with a strong interest in (primarily qualitative) fieldwork.

A key milestone in my research career was the award of the Marie Sklodowska-Curie Individual Fellowship "NEIGHBOURCHANGE-Social innovation and urban revitalization in hyperdiverse local societies" in 2017. Since 2018, I have been active in the AESOP Thematic Group Public Spaces and Urban Cultures where I can profit from networking and knowledge exchange with some of the most important scholars in my research field. Since 2014 I am a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the National Research Group on Urban Regeneration Urban@IT.

Since 2012 I've collaborated with the **SSIIM UNESCO Chair Research Centre** that gave me the opportunity to develop **creative independent thinking** being immersed in an interdisciplinary and international research group. Thanks to this collaboration, in 2013 I had the opportunity to be involved in another **Marie Curie Fellowship Programme in Mexico City** (part of RISE EU Funded Project) collaborating with the Instituto Mora and conducting a field research about urban policies for the inclusion of international migrants in most-deprived neighbourhoods.

I have extensive project management experience. While collaborating with the SSIIM Unesco Chair, I contributed to the **project design and management** of 3 major collaborative research projects: i) Urgent: urban re-generation European network of towns, Europe for citizens Program ii) SHARING SPACE: intercultural cities and collective space, FP7-PEOPLE-2012-IRSES iii) MIUM-TIE, Managing International Urban Migration in Turkey Italy and Spain, EC, Civil Society Dialogue between the EU and Turkey. Within SSIIM UNESCO Chair, I contributed to the conception and design of **10 collaborative research projects**, funded by national and international donors.

Today I'm part of the leading group of **1 million EU-funded ERAMUS+ project named EUREKA** working on the definition of a new European curricula for MA teaching on urban regeneration and social innovation. I've just finished a 1-year **research collaboration for the Ministry of Italian Culture** on a national mapping effort of community based action directed to urban regeneration trough culture. I'm part of the international research project SOLIVID (leaded by the University of Barcelona) on mapping and evaluating the impact of community based action in the urban welfare effort during the pandemic outbreak.

I'm among the founder and vice-director of the **Master U-Rise- Urban regeneration and social innovation** at IUAV of Venice, the first Italian Master course on these topics.

During my career, I have been involved in **university teaching**, at both MA and undergraduate levels and I have **supervised** both master students, PhD students and postdoc researchers (see CV for details). I today teach 'Strumenti per il Riuso e la Rigenerazione Urbana' at Iuav di Venezia and 'Innovazione nel governo locale' at the U-Rise Master.
