Profile

Federico Zanfi (1978) studied architecture in Italy and Spain and holds a Phd in Urban projects and policies from Politecnico di Milano. Here he works as Associate Professor in Urbanism at the Department of Architecture and Urban Studies.

His design and research activity gravitates around the “post-growth” transformation of the 20th century built heritage and infrastructures, with a focus on Italian urban systems. Within this frame he has developed reform strategies and carried out consultancy for unauthorized settlements in the *Mezzogiorno*, for scattered urbanization and industrial clusters in central-northern regions, and for middle-class housing in the main metropolitan areas.
